5-STAND SUMMER LEAGUE 2009

The following rules apply:

1. League shoots on Thursday evenings, starting at 5:00pm.
2. 50 targets per round – Total cost - \$13.00. \$4.00 of this fee goes toward trophy and prize money - \$9.00 for targets.
3. 100 target shoot-off - \$26.00.
4. A \$10.00 registration fee will be collected on shooters first league round, All of which will be returned in trophy and prize money.
5. Low gun position is mandatory. Butt of gunstock shall be held below chest level and at or behind vertical plane of shoulder. Gun mount can not begin until target is called for and target has clearly exited house. Shooter will be allowed one warning per League round. After one warning shooter shall be penalized one target for each violation. Decision of scorer shall be final. Arguments will not be tolerated and may result in additional penalties being assessed by Winter League Committee including, but not limited to, loss of additional targets, exclusion of round from target total, and expulsion from field and/or League without refund.
6. Seven (7) League rounds (total 350 targets) are required to be eligible for the shoot-off.
7. All trophies and prize money are based on shoot-off scores, except for determination of High Average winner.
8. The trophy for High Average will be awarded based on highest 8 qualifying shoots with ties being decided by Long Run.
9. Champion, Runner-Up and Class winners will receive trophies or can opt to receive money in lieu of trophy.
10. One (1) free box of shells is awarded for 50 straight targets shot in the same round.
11. Shooters will be allowed make-ups, or to shoot ahead, which must be shot on or before August 20, 2009.

12. Shoot-off classifications will be determined after August 20, 2009 League round.
13. Champion, Runner-Up and Class ties will be determined by a shoot-off.
14. Shooter will not be allowed to regress below the previous year's earned League average. If none, the Known Ability Rule will apply to that shooter. Prior year class Winners (in winter or summer 5-stand Leagues) are not eligible to shoot in the same or lower class in the shoot-off and will be automatically advanced to the next highest class.
15. Classification for the shoot-off's purse money will be on a handicap basis to equalize all shooters. A shooter's handicap will be determined by the seven (7) highest scores registered before the shoot-off. Each shooter will receive a handicap of 2/3 the difference between the average of his/her seven (7) highest scores and 100. Fractions will be rounded down.
16. The shooter's score, plus handicap, will yield the total score for the shoot-off. No handicapped score will be allowed to exceed 100.
17. The guaranteed purse for the 5-stand will be divided as follows for the top seven (7) scores: 21 / 17 / 15 / 14 / 13 / 11 / 9 %. The purse will be calculated on the high gun basis.
18. Trophies and Titles will be determined by scratch scores and classes will be determined by a Lewis Class system.
19. It is required that the smallest gauge used for any League round must be used for the shoot-off.
20. If necessary, League shooters will be given priority over practice shooters and those shooting for the current day's score will be given preference over make-ups and shoot-aheads.
21. League participants must have had at least their 14th birthday and be proficient in the safe-handling of firearms.
22. Participants aged 14 through 17 must be accompanied and supervised by a parent or legal guardian while shooting.
23. Any inappropriate and/or unsafe conduct will not be tolerated and will subject the violator to expulsion from the League without refund.
24. Decisions of the Summer League Committee as to all League matters shall govern; are final; and shall be made by the Committee in its sole and absolute discretion.
25. In order to be eligible to participate in the shoot-off, each shooter must have assisted in running the league by opening and closing the fields, collecting money, scoring, pulling, and shoveling as needed.

26. There will be a concurrent Sub-Gauge event, 20ga or smaller. A \$2.00 fee per round will be charged with all fees being returned to the sub-gauge shooters. 7 or less shooters, 1 class, 60-40 split. More than 7 shooters, 2 classes. Sub-gauge shooters are eligible to participate in the main event. All sub-gauge shooters must shoot all qualifying rounds with a sub-gauge firearm.
